I am pleased to write this letter in support of the work Denise Lodge and the Coalition of Riders Educating Youth (C.O.R.E.Y.) have done over the past number of years with the Ride and Drive Safe presentation for schools.

RoadSafetyBC has been proud to work with Ms. Lodge in order to facilitate these presentations over the past few years. CoreySafe has given 23 presentations in the Northern part of British Columbia thus far (2016 and 2017), reaching approximately 4,800 students. RoadSafetyBC has supported this program, helping to draft the presentation materials, and has directly participated in 10 presentations reaching approximately 1,900 students.

Each year on average, 32 British Columbians lose their lives in crashes in motorcycles.
